The decision follows a comprehensive business review aimed at safeguarding and strengthening the company's competitiveness in the Asia-Pacific region. With its strong tyre manufacturing network in the region, the company serves replacement customers and original equipment customers alike.

Amidst intense competition and high price sensitivity in the TBR segment, sustaining long-term value from Continental's premium offerings has been a significant challenge. Hence, Continental's truck and bus radial tyre business manufacturing operations in India will be

discontinued as of June 2025. The company's priority is to support its employees by providing assistance and support such as career counselling as well as exploring potential employment opportunities inside and outside of Continental. In addition, a voluntary retirement and separation scheme will be offered.

India remains a strategically important market for Continental's tyre business. Committed to sustainable and long-term business growth, Continental aims to further strengthen its market position in India as the trusted premium tyre partner. The company is present with sales and distribution activities headquartered in Faridabad (Haryana), manufacturing operations for passenger and light truck tyres in Modipuram Meerut, Uttar Pradesh and has recently opened an IT Hub in Bengaluru.
